# **CONSENT ORDER**

UPON the application of the Claimant by letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> October 2021

AND UPON the Claimant being the registered freehold proprietor of three adjacent parcels of land and buildings at Weirfields, Totnes, under HM Land Registry title numbers DN415314. DN168957 and DN55970 (together "the Site")

AND UPON the Defendant being the local planning authority for the area in which the Site is situate

AND UPON the Defendant including the Site within the Totnes Neighbourhood Area when designating the same pursuant to s. 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990

AND ON READING the Claimant's Details of Claim dated 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021 and the witness statement of David Seaton dated 7<sup>th</sup> September 2021

AND the parties having agreed terms.

## BY CONSENT IT IS DECLARED THAT:

- 1. The South Hams District Council Community Right to Build Order for Totness Neighbourhood Area 2017 ("the Order") has lapsed.
- That the development of the Site for which planning permission was granted by the Order cannot be constructed lawfully without a further and separate grant of planning permission.

## AND BY CONSENT IT IS ORDERED THAT:
